### **Annual Meeting**

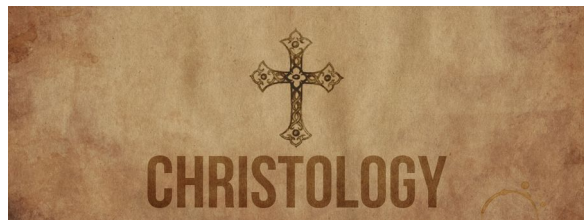

**Christology**  
**Wednesday, January 23 at 7pm**

The early church had a lot to say about who Jesus Christ is, not just what he's done. Some of what they have to say is perplexing, especially the writings from the Council of Chalcedon. For instance, Chalcedon says that Christ is visible and invisible, mutable and immutable, etc. How can all of that be true? In this talk, Jared Henderson will present a version of a paper he has recently had accepted for publication on Chalcedonian Christology. We will discuss what the early church said about Christ, why they said it, and what this means for us today.
